



Community Housing Network – Quick Facts

- Community Housing Network (CHN) is devoted to providing homes for people in need and access to resources to create sustainable communities.
 - CHN helps people who are homeless, people with disabilities and others in need find affordable housing solutions.
 - CHN's programs and services include*:
 - Housing Resource Center
 - Asset Management/Property Management Services
 - Leasing Assistance and Shelter Plus Care Programs
 - Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) Administration
 - Affordable Housing Development
 - Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)
 - Community Education and Advocacy

- CHN is the largest supportive housing provider in Oakland and Macomb counties.
 - Last year, CHN's Leasing Assistance and Shelter Plus Care programs provided housing-related supportive services to 350 adults and children who were previously homeless, in need and living with a disability.

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- Last year, CHN helped 77 adults and children successfully exit our supportive housing programs to move on to self-sufficiency.
- CHN serves as the lead organization for the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) in Oakland County, providing critical data to service providers, the press and policy makers regarding homelessness statistics.
- CHN has accessed over \$2.3 million in HUD Section 811 funding and tapped nearly \$2.1 million in local HOME and Federal Home Loan Bank Affordable Housing Program grant funds – resulting in over 320 units of housing for people in need.
- CHN is active in numerous homelessness and disability advocacy organizations, serving on committees, boards and in other capacities to ensure the voice of the people we serve is represented.
- CHN is a 501c(3) nonprofit organization that uses local, state, federal and private resources to carry out its work to promote affordable housing in our region.
