CHN finds tailored housing solutions for people across Michigan who are experiencing a crisis, homelessness, or facing obstacles due to a disability, income, or hardship.

We build affordable, accessible housing and provide assistance through our Housing Resource Center, the gateway to:

**Help:** We answer over 25,000 calls annually. Our caring Housing Navigators, Case Managers, and Housing Educators work one-on-one with individuals and families to help with everything from a single need to comprehensive long-term support.

**Housing:** We connect thousands of people each year to our network of affordable housing, short-term and long-term rentals, homeownership options, and supportive homes for people with disabilities.

**Hope:** Once housing is secured, CHN works hand-in-hand with people to pursue healthcare and mental health treatment, education, employment, financial stability, community support systems, and overall quality of life.
