2024 IMPACT



In 2024, Community Housing Network helped more than 17,000 people, investing \$12.5 million into the community, so children, families, people with disabilities and other vulnerable populations can live in stable, dignified homes.

Our Housing Resource Center assisted **12,990 people**, connecting them to resources to secure or maintain housing.



We provided compassionate, affordable property management services for **734 households** in Oakland, Macomb, Wayne and St. Clair Counties, helping people with disabilities and other vulnerable populations live as independently as they are able.

Our 11 multi-family communities are home to **758 people**, **including 358 children**, including people of low income, with disabilities, or survivors of domestic violence.

We are the largest permanent supportive housing provider in Oakland and Macomb Counties, as well as offering services in Wayne County. In the past year, Community Housing Network served 566 people, including 177 children, with leasing assistance and other essential support.



Our Homeless Prevention services helped **523 people** with financial assistance, case management services or both, allowing them to stay in their homes rather than face eviction. Keeping people in their homes is less costly and traumatic than homelessness.

Our Rapid Rehousing program assisted

420 people who were experiencing
homelessness or fleeing domestic
violence by placing them into homes.



We helped **201 people** move to "higheropportunity communities," providing them with housing stability.

Our Certified Housing Counselors educated **192 households** regarding their credit, debt, budgeting, and tenant/homeowner rights.

Our PATH Street Outreach team engaged **167 people** experiencing homelessness, on the streets of metro Detroit, providing them with direct services or connecting them to other available resources.
